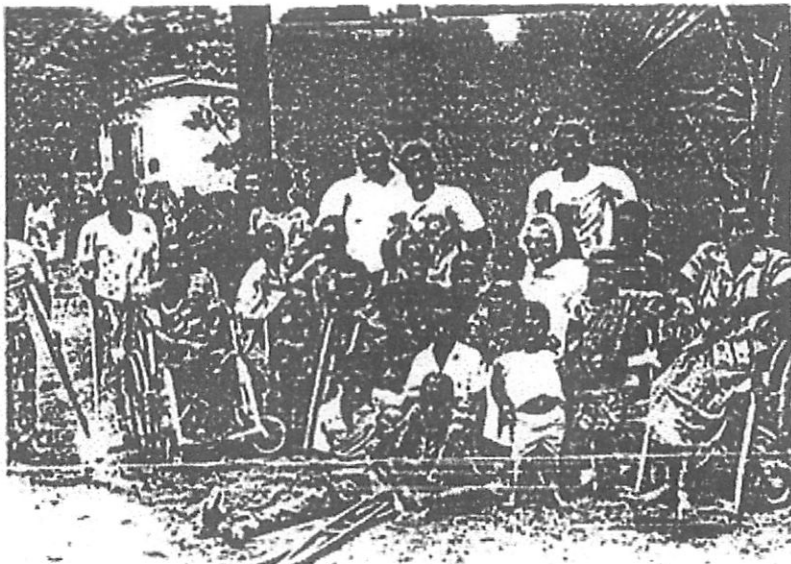

Thank for considering the children's taste for their staple food rice and for supplying it. You will never know on this earth what a tremendous assist this is to. God will truly reward you both splendidly for this concern and action. All we can give will be our continued prayers for all your very special intentions. We shall beg God to let you all share in the many joys that will be the children's as they eat this precious commodity.

Paula also sent us some tapes which the children are enjoying. Thanks again for this consideration. She is really a go getter. Once we informed her about our plight she got on the ball and had things working fine. Thanks for leading us to her too.

The children are all doing well. We just finished our semi finals and many of them got on the honor roll. Some of the handicapped topped their classes and this always pleases me to let them know that they too can achieve if they want to.

We have such plans to get settled that we pray it happens soon. We know that God will help us but we still have a little anxiety about returning to Liberia. It seems terrible that we keep the children away from their beloved homeland. But it would truly be devastating if they got there and after several months they had to run again.

Please pray for us that we make the right decision. Prayer has sustained us during this whole war of seven years so I am confident it will gain especially when backed with your prayers for us.

Incidentally Mr. Ahombo gave us one hundred ninety six thousand CFA plus his own sixty four thousand will net us approximately twenty two and a half bags of rice, CFA, we use two each day so God reward you super splendidly for this terrific benevolence and assist. We shall never forget your goodness to us.
